I have been working with Julie Stone, a camp leader, for several years promoting a very special project. The kids who attend these week-long camps are classified as abused or at-risk. They are in desperate need of love, acceptance and a big boost to their self-esteem. While they sleep after a day of fun, their carers and leaders use photographs taken during the day to create a memory album for every child. These albums, in many cases, are the only childhood photos these kids will ever own. They are overwhelmingly popular with the children, and greatly cherished.

What we can do to help is create blank 6"x6" layouts, then all the leaders have to do is add the photo and write a little journalling. Photographs are 5" x 3.5", so a mat to suit that size is excellent (5.5" x 4"). Use a small piece of adhesive on journal spots so they can be repositioned if necessary. No need for stickers or titles, as the counsellors embellish to suit the photo.
