



# Project Sheet

## Vellum Feathers



Cut out the template, place on top of the vellum and cut out the shape.

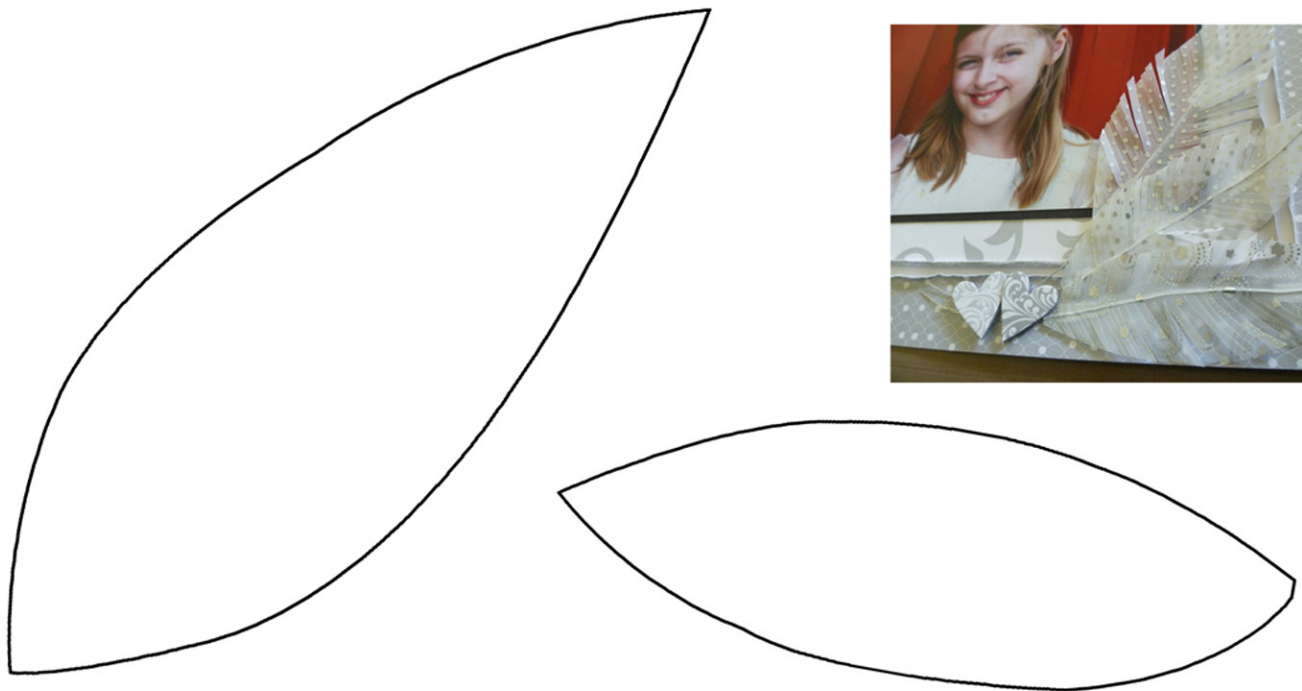
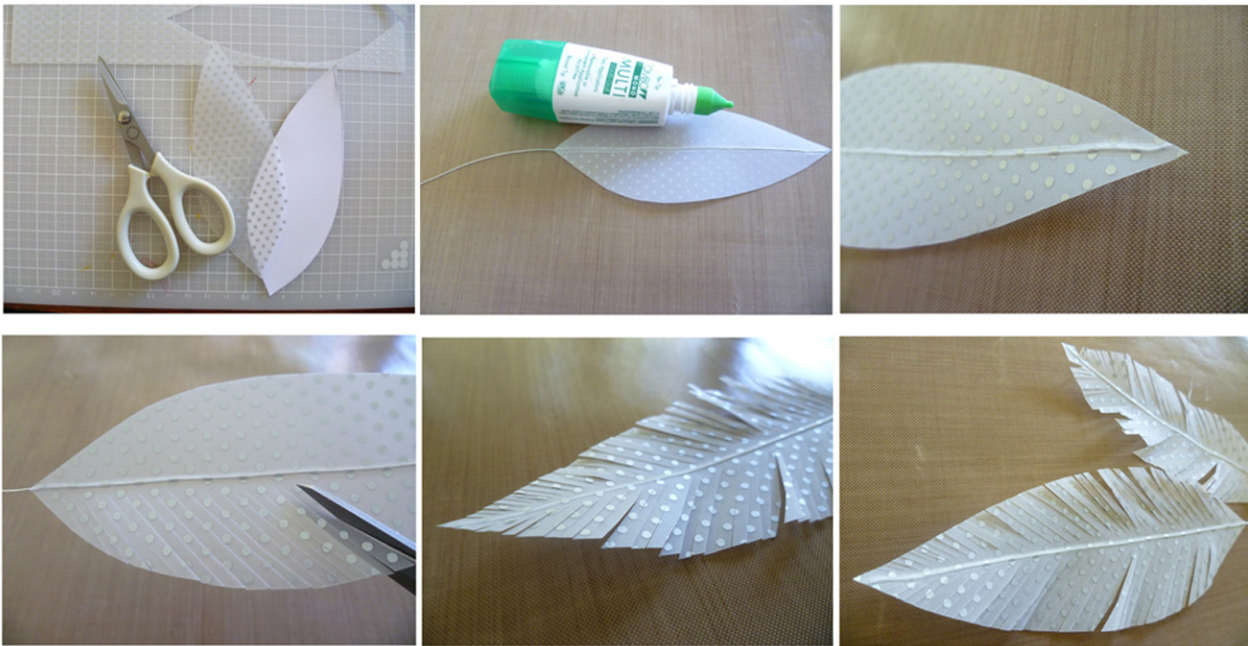
Run a bead of white glue up the centre of the leaf shape on the back.

Place some wire or thin cord onto the line of glue and trim with 5-10cm tail.

Hold the wire/cord in place while the glue dries.

When dry, turn the feather over and use your fingernails or a bone folder to score each side of the wire to form a vein.

Use small scissors to cut along each side to mimic the look of a feather.
