



Project Sheet Glitter Silhouettes



Materials

Canvas
Acrylic paint
White glue
Fine paintbrush
Ruby Rock-It glitter (coarse or fine)
Piece of scrap paper A4, folded in half and unfolded (to catch excess glitter)
Template & pencil

Method

Paint the canvas with acrylic paint. Dry. (May require more than one coat).
Trace on your silhouette.
Paint inside the silhouette area with white glue.
Hold the canvas over the paper and sprinkle glitter generously over the glue area.
Tip the excess glitter back into the jar. Allow glue to dry. Tap canvas & brush away excess glitter.



You can find more silhouettes by doing a google search, eg. child silhouette, animal silhouette, bird silhouette.

Create a silhouette of your child by taking a photograph of them side-on. Place a piece of tracing paper over the photograph and trace around the edge. Use this as your template on your canvas.

Alternatively, you can mix your glitter into some mod podge or white glue before painting it onto your canvas. This will stop the glitter from coming off later.

You can apply some Dimensional Magic (or similar) over the glittered design (when the glue is dry) to keep the glitter sealed in.



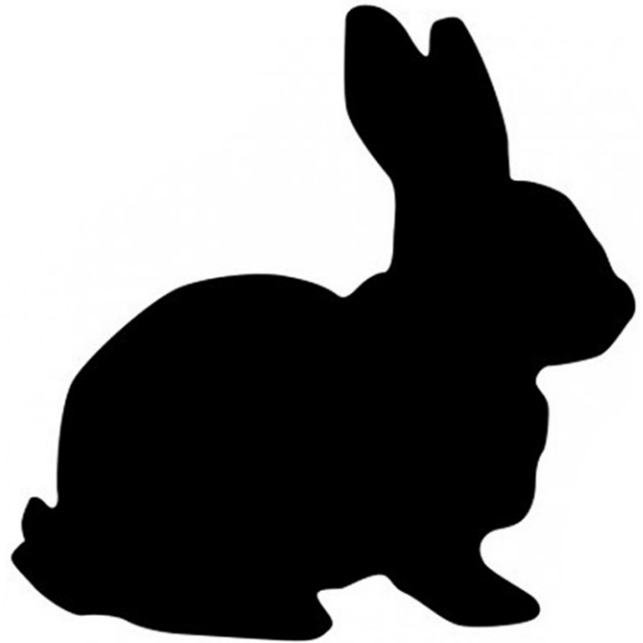
