



# Project Sheet

## Simple Gift Wrap

### Materials

Plain Brown wrapping paper  
Paper doileys (various sizes)  
Sticky Tape  
Double Sided Tape  
Scissors  
Marker or stamps & inepad  
Twine or ribbon



### Instructions

Cut the brown wrapping paper to size for each individual gift.  
Wrap the gift & secure sticky tape. Write or stamp your greeting on the paper doiley.  
Use small pieces of double sided tape to stick the doily to the wrapped gift.  
Tie up with twine or ribbon.  
Place under the tree, and give to family and friends.  
Enjoy!

You could also use patterned wrapping paper, or another plain coloured paper, like red, silver or gold. If you're on a budget, keep an eye out for 5m rolls of wrapping paper after Christmas when the stores mark their Christmas stock down by 75%. Store it away for next year, but put a note in your diary, on your calendar or in your phone, to remind you where you put it!

You can find paper doileys at dollar shops, discount stores and kitchenware stores, and are available in different sizes and shapes. Alternatively, if you have a doiley die for your diecutting machine, you could cut your own from printer paper.

If you don't have twine, you could use curling ribbon, fabric ribbon or even a strip of pretty paper. Or maybe you could just keep the gifts plain, with paper & doiley only!

On the show I wrapped my gift with plain brown paper wrapping, bought in the back to school sales. The doileys were purchased from my local dollar shop, and the twine was from my kitchen drawer.
